# Act I

# **Pre-Show**

(The DOTS are dressed as ushers and help audience to their seats.)

Pre-show Announcement

# Scene 1: Ready?

(As the Pre-show Announcement ends, PAGE and TURNER are escorted to their seats by YELLOW (dressed all in yellow), who is currently an usher. They're not the ideal audience members for late-seating; they make a lot of noise, and if no seats are available, they try to sit on other people's laps. YELLOW tries to mitigate all of this behavior, apologizing to audience members as needed, until the clowns are reasonably settled. Then ....)

# **YELLOW**

Ready?

# **PAGE**

Wait. Ready for what?

### **YELLOW**

The Dot Shop

# TURNER

Oh, I'm ready. Page, are you ready?

# PAGE

Oh, I'm ready, Turner.

#### TURNER

Great. We're ready! (asks YELLOW) Are you ready?

(YELLOW nods in agreement.)

# **PAGE**



Perfect. Wait, is there anybody else who needs to be ready? (YELLOW *gestures to the audience*) Oh! (to TURNER) Do you think they're ready?

# **TURNER**

I don't know... How do we know if everyone's ready?

# **PAGE**

Ask them! Hey, are you all ready? (*Audience says yes, kinda*.) That doesn't sound like you're ready. Are you ready?

(Yes.)

### **TURNER**

ARE YOU READY!?

(YES!)

# **TURNER**

Yes! (turns back) Except, now I've forgotten what we're ready for.

# **ALL DOTS**

The Dot Shop

# **PAGE**

Yes! That's the musical we're here to watch.

# **YELLOW**

I'm sorry, I don't think you understand.

# SONG

IN A WORLD OF COLORS, WHERE JOY IS FOUND, THERE'S A LITTLE FRIEND, LET'S GATHER 'ROUND. SHE'S NOT LIKE THE OTHERS, OH NO, NOT SHE, SHE'S A DOTTY FRIEND, AS HAPPY AS CAN BE!

DOTTY, DOTTY, DANCE AROUND, IN A WORLD WHERE JOY IS FOUND. YELLOW DOTS SO BRIGHT AND FREE, YELLOW DOTS COME PLAY WITH ME!

(Beat. TURNER is impressed.)



# **TURNER**

Wow, even the ushers sing at this show!

#### **PAGE**

Yes, very nice. But when is the real thing going to start? No offense to you, I mean. That was lovely. But are the actors going to come out, or...

(YELLOW sighs and points at the dot on the PROGRAM.)

# **YELLOW**

Be Dotty!

#### **PAGE**

You want us to do something?

### **TURNER**

Uh-oh. If this is one of those audience participation shows, I'm gonna move to the back.

(TURNER starts to move to the back of the house.)

### **YELLOW**

Come on!

#### **PAGE**

Turner, the singing usher seems to really think it's important, so I think we better do it. It's a little embarrassing being singled out like this...

### **TURNER**

Yeah, well, if I have to do it then everybody should do it! (*rallies the crowd*) Okay, when the usher tells you to "Be Dotty" we're all gonna press the dot on our program. And it's gonna sound like this: Boop!

# PAGE

(asking YELLOW) Is that what you want?

# YELLOW

(nodding excitedly) Yeah! Ready?

### SONG

(Everyone presses the yellow dot on their program, making a "Boop" sound with their voices. "Ka-shunk." A yellow dot appears on stage. The next actor to sing stands up in the audience and joins in. In the original production, this was the actor playing BLUE.)



#### YELLOW and BLUE

SO IF YOU'RE FEELING BLUE, LIKE THE SADDEST OF SPOTS, JUST REMEMBER DOTTY, CONNECTING THE DOTS. IN A WORLD OF COLORS, WHERE JOY IS SPUN, DOTTY'S LOVE SHINES LIKE THE MORNING SUN.

DOTTY, DOTTY, DANCE AROUND, IN A WORLD WHERE JOY IS FOUND. YELLOW and BLUE DOTS SO BRIGHT AND FREE, YELLOW and BLUE DOTS COME PLAY WITH ME!

(Press. "Boop." "Ka-shunk." A yellow dot appears.)

# PAGE / TURNER

Woah! Look at that!

(Press. "Boop." "Ka-shunk." A third yellow dot appears.)

#### YELLOW and BLUE

WE ARE AT THIS MOMENT, THIS PARTICULAR SPOT WHERE YOU'RE STARING AT A CURTAIN WITH A BRIGHT YELLOW DOT AND IF YOU'RE THINKING THAT THIS IS THE BEGINNING: IT'S NOT CAUSE IT'S ACTUALLY A MOMENT WHERE THE STORY STOPS.

IT'S A TIME WHERE YOU DECIDE WHAT TO DO CAUSE THIS IS A STORY THAT'S REALLY ABOUT YOU IF YOU WANT TO MAKE THE ACTION HAPPEN ON STAGE THEN ALL YOU GOTTA DO IS BE DOTTY AND TURN THE PAGE.
